## GALLERY TERMS & CONDITIONS

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- ELIGIBILITY:** Lakeshore Arts provides gallery space for exhibitions by **Lakeshore Arts Artist members**.
- SCHEDULE:** Exhibitions are scheduled **bi-monthly** between December and August.
- DEADLINE:** The acceptance of applications is ongoing, however space is often limited a year in advance.
- PROCESS:** The Lakeshore Arts Gallery Committee reviews all applications and determines an exhibition schedule that reflects a diversity of artwork and community members. Applicants will be notified of the schedule 3 months before their exhibit.
- HANGING:** Artists are responsible for ensuring that their work is show-ready (framed, wired and compatible with our rod and track hanging system). Work that is not show-ready on install date will not be hung. Artist must hang and strike their own exhibition during gallery hours on a date and time prearranged with staff. Artists are responsible for damage caused by failed hanging equipment.
- HOURS:** Regular gallery hours are **Tues-Fri from 11- 5pm** and **Saturday from 11 - 2**.
- OPENING:** An opening reception can be scheduled in consultation with staff. There is no alcohol permitted at openings. All associated costs are the responsibility of the artist.
- ARTIST TALK:** As part of new gallery programming, exhibiting artists are encouraged to speak briefly about their work and process during a 10-15 minutes presentation to take place either prior or during the reception. This is a great opportunity to share ideas, personal history and process with visitors to the reception.
- MARKETING:** Lakeshore Arts will include the exhibition information in our eblasts and on our Facebook page. Artists are responsible for any additional marketing efforts and costs. Printed materials must include the Lakeshore Arts logo and be preapproved by staff.
- FEES:** There is no fee to exhibit. **Lakeshore Arts receives 20% on any sale of work** that is generated during the duration of the exhibition. Purchasers will pay Lakeshore Arts, who will in turn pay the artist, less 20%.
- SPACE:** Please note that the gallery is a shared space. Lakeshore Arts offers a variety of workshops for youth and adults, along with children's programming. While the programs are facilitated by professionals, exhibiting at the Smith Zone does not offer exclusivity over the space.
- LIABILITY:** Lakeshore Arts has the right to refuse any piece that cannot be hung safely in the space. While all due care will be taken with artwork, Lakeshore Arts does not assume liability for loss or damage of artwork, however caused.
