Lakeshore Arts and Kaeja d'Dance welcomes residents and families of New Toronto, situated between First Street to Thirteenth Street Third, south of Lake Shore Blvd, to partake in Porch View Dances: New Toronto, a community dance event with generous support from a family of supporters. Conceived by Karen Kaeja and developed with Allen Kaeja, Porch View Dances: Real People Dancing In Real Spaces, has seen success in Seaton Village for over seven years. In the manner of a guided neighbourhood tour, audience members travel from house to house to see new dance works created with professional choreographers and performed by local families on the porches and front yards of their own homes. The tour culminates in an audience participatory Flock Landing group dance in a local park, yet to be determined.
