



Lakeshore Art's Member's Exhibition 2017

Terms of Entry

Membership must be in good standing. Maximum one piece per artist can be exhibited, within size restriction of approximately 3' x 3' (negotiable). Acceptance is on a first come first served basis as there are limited spots available. Review, complete and submit this form along with an artist statement, bio or cv and image of your selected work by **Tuesday September 5th 2017**. Completed applications accepted via email to our Gallery Coordinator Jacqui at jacqui@lakeshorearts.ca, dropped in our secure mailbox or delivered in person during operating hours to 2422 Lake Shore Blvd West.

1. **Artists will drop off their artwork on Monday October 2nd between 11am – 5pm and pick up their work on Monday October 30th between 11am-5pm.** If the artist is not available to drop-off or pick up their work they may make arrangements for someone to do so on their behalf. Please contact the Gallery Coordinator to make alternate arrangements.
2. Artwork must be the sole work of the artist participant. Copies of work from other artists, collaborative works that are not credited or incorporation of any copyrighted imagery that is not the property of the artist will not be accepted.
3. Artwork must be suitably framed and/or wired to be hung prior to delivery. Artwork must be “show-ready” and any work delivered on site without proper equipment will not be hung or showed. Artists are responsible for any damage caused by faulty or improper hardware.
4. Any work that cannot be hung in a frame or with a wire will need to be cleared with the Gallery Coordinator prior to drop-off day. The Gallery Coordinator will do their best to accommodate the hanging of non-traditional works when possible.
5. While we accept submissions from all media, there is limited space for sculptural work. Artists are responsible for providing their own plinths if required for the piece.
6. The gallery is a shared space that offers a range of programs and events for all ages. While programs are facilitated by professionals, exhibiting in the Lakeshore Arts Gallery does not provide exclusivity over the space.
7. Insurance is provided against vandalism, theft, fire, smoke or water damage, but not against accidental breakage of glass or fragile article damage. A value must be given if the work is not for sale. Lakeshore Arts has liability coverage for the value of the work in our exhibitions but artists are encouraged to have their own insurance on artwork of a high monetary value.
8. Lakeshore Arts receives a 20% commission on any sale(s) of artwork
9. The Lakeshore Arts' Gallery Coordinator is responsible for curating the show; in the event of a conflict of opinion on any aspect of the installation, final decision rests with the Gallery Coordinator including refusal of any piece that cannot be displayed safely in the space.
10. Works must conform to the City of Toronto Workplace and Human Rights Policy which can be found at www.toronto.ca
11. An Artist's Reception for the exhibition will be held Thursday October 12th, 6 - 8pm
