**Terms of Entry**

Membership must be in good standing. Maximum one piece per artist can be exhibited. Acceptance is on a first come first served basis as there are limited spots available. Complete and return this form by Monday September 28<sup>th</sup> 2015. Completed forms are accepted via email to our Program Manager at [kim@lakeshorearts.ca](mailto:kim@lakeshorearts.ca), dropped in our secure mailbox or delivered in person during operating hours.

1. **Artists will drop off their artwork on Monday October 5<sup>th</sup> between 11am – 6pm and pick up their work on Monday December 8<sup>th</sup> between 11am-6pm.** If the artist is not available to drop-off or pick up their work they may make arrangements for someone to do so on their behalf. Please contact the Program Manager to make alternate arrangements.
2. Artwork must be the sole work of the artist participant. Copies of work from other artists, collaborative works that are not credited or incorporation of any copy written imagery that is not the property of the artist participant will not be accepted.
3. Artwork must be suitably framed and/or wired to be hung prior to delivery. Artwork must be "show-ready" and any work delivered on site without proper equipment will not be hung or showed. Artists are responsible for any damage caused by faulty or improper hardware.
4. Any work that cannot be hung in a frame or with a wire will need to be cleared with the Program Manager prior to drop-off day. The Program Manager will do their best to accommodate the hanging of non-traditional works when possible.
5. Insurance is provided against vandalism, theft, fire, smoke or water damage, but not against accidental breakage of glass or fragile article damage. A value must be given if the work is not for sale. Lakeshore Arts has liability coverage for the value of the work in our exhibitions but artists are encouraged to have their own insurance on artwork of a high monetary value.
6. Dimensions of artwork cannot exceed 2 feet (width/length) including the frame. There is limited space for 3 dimensional or sculptural work.
7. Lakeshore Arts receives a 20% commission on any sale(s) of artwork
8. Lakeshore Arts' Program Manager is responsible for curating the show; in the event of a conflict of opinion on any aspect of the installation, final decision rests with the Program Manager including refusal of any piece that cannot be displayed safely in the space.
9. Works must confirm to the City of Toronto Workplace and Human Rights Policy which can be found at [www.toronto.ca](http://www.toronto.ca)
10. An Artists Reception for the work will be held Saturday October 24<sup>th</sup> from 12:00-2:00pm.
